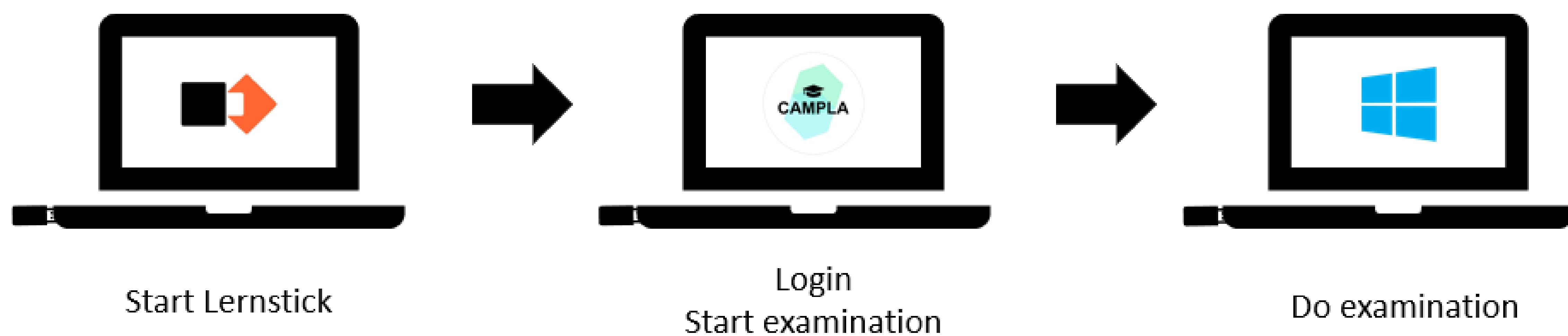


E-Assessment on BYOD

Current situation

Digitalization is making its way into educational institutions and more and more students bring their own computer for study (**Bring Your Own Device**). Often, the digitally imparted knowledge has to be adapted to an analogue format, because assessments still rely on paper. This can lead to a distortion of the proof of competence.

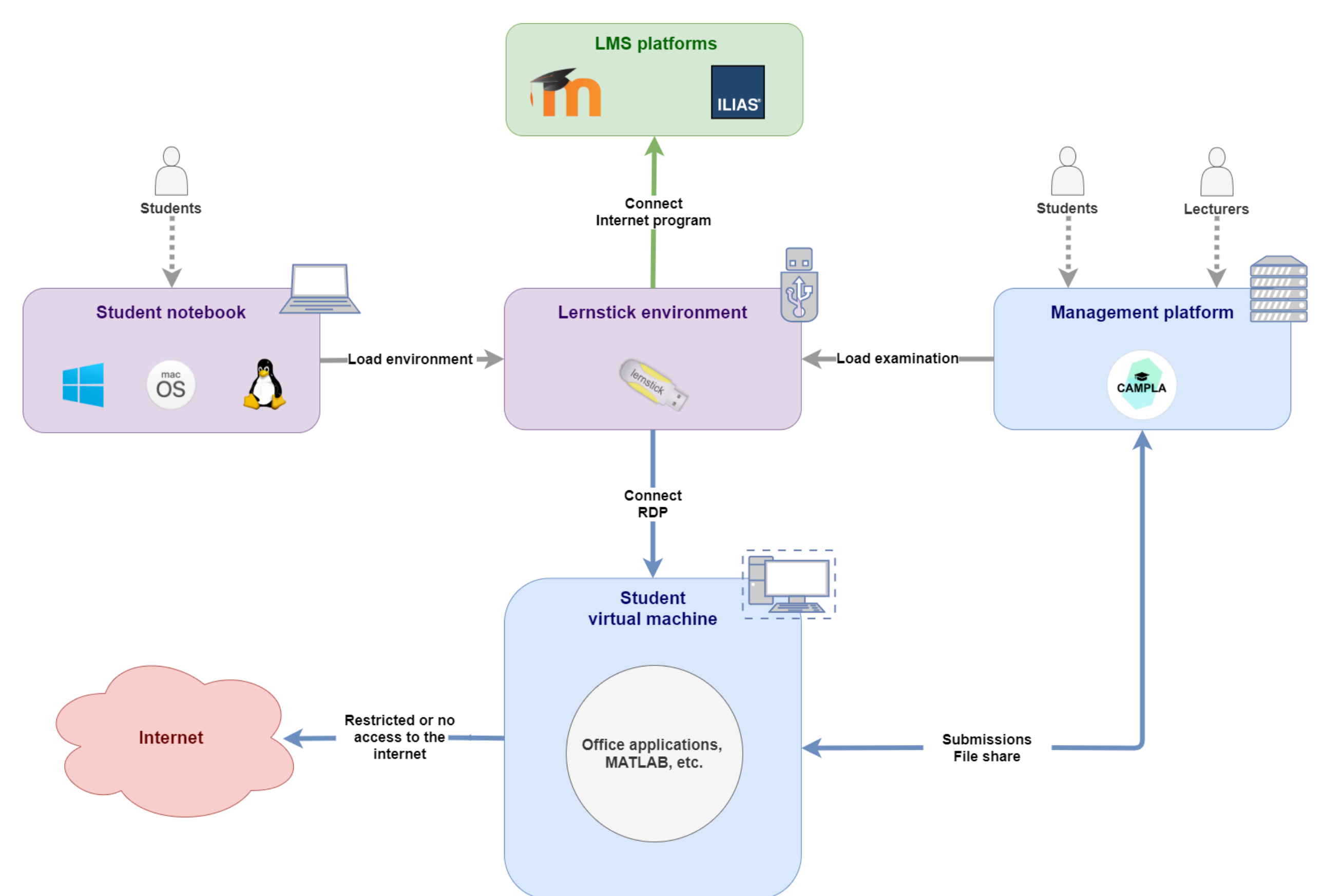


Without Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Concept:

Competence-oriented e-assessments

Students should have the opportunity to take competence-oriented digital examinations in order to be well prepared for their future working environment. The CAMPLA/Lernstick infrastructure allows examinations to be taken in a **secure environment with suitable digital tools on their own devices**. If certain competences can only be tested unsatisfactorily with a paper examination, a digital examination with CAMPLA/Lernstick offers possibilities to counteract this.

Conducting digital examinations



The procedure of an examination is the following:

- Start secure examination environment by the Lernstick
- Login with students account (SWITCH edu-ID) on the CAMPLA examination system
- After login, a connection to the individual examination is established
- The examination is taken on a virtual computer or directly on the learning management system of the educational institution.

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
